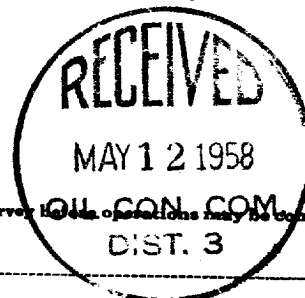

Ute Mountain Tribal "C" Well No. 2. On May 4, 1958, ran 5-1/2" casing and set at 3285 feet with stage collar at 2698'. Cemented first stage with 60 sacks 6% gel cement, followed by 55 sacks neat cement. Opened stage collar ports with 1200 pounds. Circulated with mud for 5 hours. No evidence of cement. Cemented second stage with 64.5 sacks 6% gel cement. Cement did not circulate. Used cement basket below stage tool. Closed two stage tool. Tested with 1950 pounds for 15 minutes, which held with no drop in pressure. Top cement at 530' by temperature survey.
