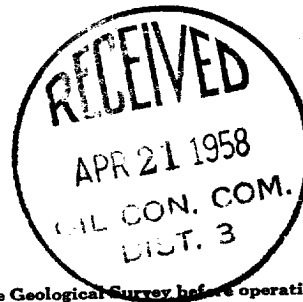

DETAILS OF WORK

Ute Mountain Tribal "C" Well No. 2 was spudded on April 8, 1958, and on April 10, 1958, 8-5/8" casing was set at 413' with 300 sacks of cement. After waiting on cement for 24 hours, casing and water shut off were tested with 500 pounds pressure for thirty minutes, which held with no drop in pressure. Drilling operations were resumed.
