

Ute Mountain Tribal "C" Well No. 2. Spotted 500 gallons 15% MCA on bottom. Perforated four shots per foot 3004-70'. Sand oil fracked 40,500 gallons oil, 40,000 pounds sand. Initial breakdown 800 pounds, average injection rate 64 BPM. 2" tubing landed at 3072'. Ute Mountain Tribal "C" No. 2 is currently being tested.
