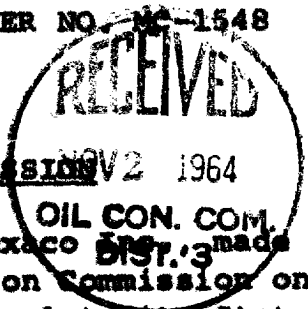


THE APPLICATION OF TEXACO INC.
FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-1548

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION



Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Texaco Inc. made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on October 7, 1964, for permission to dually complete its State of New Mexico "M" Well No. 1 located in Unit A of Section 36, Township 31 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 27th day of October, 1964, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Texaco Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its State of New Mexico "M" Well No. 1 located in Unit A of Section 36, Township 31 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Basin-Dakota Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

WELL NO. 1-124

Under the provisions of Rule 113-A, Texas Rules of Civil Procedure, the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission, on October 7, 1964, has permitted to be drilled and completed in dual completion the New Mexico Well No. 1 located in Unit A of Section 34, Township 31 North, Range 12 West, T40N, R12W, New Mexico County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Alamosa-Navajo Pool and the Santa-Manuel Pool.

Now, on this 17th day of November, 1964, the Commission

Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 113-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of oil and gas wells have been duly notified.
- (3) That no objections have been received within the time period as prescribed by said rules.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause any and injure cumulative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consistent with good conservation practices.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Texasco Inc., do and the applicant hereby authorized to duly complete the same at New Mexico Well No. 1 located in Unit A of Section 34, Township 31 North, Range 12 West, T40N, R12W, New Mexico County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Alamosa-Navajo Pool and the Santa-Manuel Pool through suitable strings of casing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, drill and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 113-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall cause production tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the delivery test period for the Santa-Manuel Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this matter hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
