Dear Frank,

We would like to flow test this well for a period of three days and flare it to atmosphere. The above referenced well is a poor producer and is about to be disconnected by Sunterra Gas Gathering Company. The current line pressure is +350 psi. We wish to flow the subject well holding 90 psi back pressure to simulate compression. If the well will produce sufficient gas at this lower pressure, we will evaluate the use of a permanent compressor to continue producing this well and recover additional reserves.

We anticipate beginning this three day test on Wednesday morning, September 9, 1987.
