**Ute Mountain Tribal "E" Well No. 3. was spudded on December 10, 1958 8-5/8" casing was set at 220' with 180 sacks of cement. After waiting on cement, casing and water shut-off were tested with 500 pounds pressure for thirty minutes which held with no drop in pressure. Reduced hole to 7-7/8" at 220' and resumed drilling operations.**
