DETAILS OF WORK

Propose To:

Set 300 feet of 2 3/8" surface casing and cement to surface. Drill with rotary to approximate total depth of 7125 feet or through the Dakota formation. Set 4 1/2" production casing at total depth and cement with 250 cu. Set two-stage cement collar approximately 100 feet below the Mesaverde formation and cement to cover both the Mesaverde and Pictured Cliffs formations. Perforate Dakota formation - Sand Water free and run 2 3/8" tubing.

West One-half, 360 acres, Section 25 dedicated to this well.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
