DETAILS OF WORK

1. Rig up rotary tools. Spudded 13-3/4" surface hole at 8:00 p.m. 9/24/62.
2. Drilled to 260'. Ran 9 joints 10-3/4", 32.75# surface casing, landed at 267.30 ft. Cemented with 150 sacks regular cement, w/2% Calcium Chloride. Plugdown at 7:30 a.m. 9/25/62. Cement circulated.
3. Pressured up to 1000# for 30 minutes, pressure held.
4. Drilling ahead with 8-3/4" hole.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
