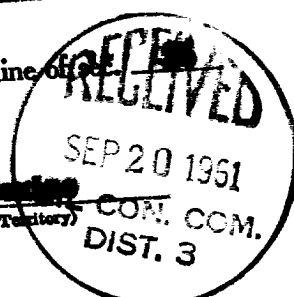

DETAILS OF WORK

This well was deepened to 1440' TD through 1-1/2" casing (set at 1340') with oil. The lower casing sand was cured and found non-productive. A cast iron bridge plug was set at 1535' in 1-1/2" casing and 1/2 inch cement was put on top of bridge plug 1535-1540' with a wireline dump boiler.

The upper casing sand was acidized with 250 gallons acid and restored to production 6-25-61. The upper casing is producing through two horizontal fractures at 1481' and 1483'.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
