Rotary Total Depth 4717 ft. 4720 ft. of 5 1/2" casing was cemented to TD with 250 sacks. Plug was pumped down and casing tested with 750# pressure for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure.

Cable tools moved on and drilled plug May 30, 1951. Bailed hole dry and tested for two hours with 500# pressure. No leaks, hole dry.
