ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:



This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on October 7, 1959, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Elvis A. Utz, Examiner duly appointed by the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," in accordance with Rule 1214 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

NOW, on this 21<sup>st</sup> day of October, 1959, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence adduced, and the recommendations of the Examiner, Elvis A. Utz, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant is the operator of a 40-acre tract in the E/2 W/2 of Section 28, Township 31 North, Range 16 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the SE/4 SW/4 of said Section 28; thence North 3,023.65 feet; thence West 560.90 feet; thence South 3,023.65 feet; thence East 593.79 feet to the point of beginning.

(3) That the applicant proposes the establishment of a non-standard oil proration unit in the Horseshoe-Gallup Oil Pool, comprising the above-described 40-acre tract.

mission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Com-  
mission," in accordance with Rule 101 of the Commission  
Rules and Regulations.

On this day of October, 1952, the Com-  
mission, a quorum being present, having considered the  
application, the evidence adduced, and the recommendations  
of the Examiner, Elva A. Uss, and being fully advised in  
the premises,

Find:

(1) That the applicant having been given notice  
by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of the case  
and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant is the operator of a business  
located in the S/W 1/4 of Section 22, Township 21 N., Range  
10 E., San Juan County, New Mexico, where the following  
are located as follows:

Beginning at the south west corner of the  
S/W 1/4 of said Section 22; thence North  
1,000.00 feet; thence East 500.00 feet;  
thence South 1,000.00 feet; thence East  
500.00 feet to the point of beginning.

(3) That the applicant proposes the establishment of a  
non-steady oil protection unit in the above-described  
location and the above-described acreage.

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(4) That the applicant proposes to dedicate the above-described non-standard oil proration unit to the Horseshoe Ute Well No. 27 to be drilled at an unorthodox location 330 feet from the South line and 4,430 feet from the East line of said Section 28.

(5) That approval of the subject application will neither cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That a 40-acre non-standard oil proration unit in the Horseshoe-Gallup Oil Pool be and the same is hereby established in the E/2 W/2 of Section 28, Township 31 North, Range 16 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the SE/4 SW/4 of said Section 28; thence North 3,023.65 feet; thence West 560.90 feet; thence South 3,023.65 feet; thence East 593.79 feet to the point of beginning.

(2) That the applicant be and the same is hereby authorized to dedicate the above-described non-standard oil proration unit to the Horseshoe Ute Well No. 27 hereby authorized to be drilled at an unorthodox location 330 feet from the South line and 4,430 feet from the East line of said Section 28.

(1) That the applicant proposes to reserve a certain portion of the non-standard oil production unit of the Horseshoe-Galap Oil Pool to be drilled at an unorthodox location 200 feet from the south line and 4,400 feet from the east line of said Section 28.

(2) That approval of the subject application will confer upon the owner certain exclusive rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That a 10-acre non-standard oil production unit in the Horseshoe-Galap Oil Pool to be drilled at an unorthodox location 200 feet from the south line and 4,400 feet from the east line of said Section 28, Township 31 North, Range 10 East, Tarrant County, Texas, be reserved, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the southeast corner of the 2 1/2 x 3 1/2 of said Section 28; thence north 89° 58' 00" east; thence west 500.00 feet; thence south 89° 58' 00" east; thence east 500.00 feet to the point of beginning.

(2) That the applicant do and the same is hereby authorized to dedicate the above-described non-standard oil production unit to the Horseshoe-Galap Oil Pool to be drilled at an unorthodox location 200 feet from the south line and 4,400 feet from the east line of said Section 28.
