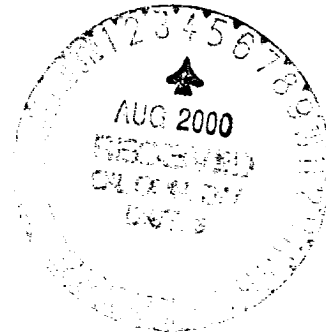

**Plugging and Abandonment Procedure  
Horseshoe Gallup Unit No. 162  
Attachment "A"**

**Well Data:**

Location: 1650' FSL, 330' FWL, Section 27 T31N, R16W  
San Juan County New Mexico

TD: 1562'  
PBTD: 1538'

Surface Casing: 8-5/8", 24 ppf, J-55 set @ 72' with 80 sacks

Production Casing: 5-1/2", J-55 set @ 1555' with 125 sacks

Perforations: 1498' -1528' with 4SPF

**Procedure:**

1. Release packer and TOH w/tubing.
2. Trip in hole with cement retainer and set at 1400'.
3. Mix and pump 33 sacks of cement below retainer. Pull out of retainer and set 25 sack plug on top of retainer. Estimated top of cement @ 1275'.
4. Trip out of hole and lay down tubing.
5. Perforate squeeze holes 120'
6. Establish circulation down casing, through annulus and out bradenhead.
7. Mix and pump 50 sacks of cement down casing through perforations, into annulus and out through bradenhead. Leave casing and annulus full of cement.
8. Cut off casing and install regulation dry hole marker.
9. Reclaim location as per BLM regulations.
