- 1785' to 1550' - 64 sacks regular mix poxmix plus 2% gel.
- 425' to 325' - 27 sacks regular mix poxmix plus 2% gel.
- 125' to 95' - 20 sacks regular mix poxmix plus 2% gel.
- 38' to 8' - 10 sacks common cement.

A dry hole marker was installed and the location cleaned up according to regulation.
