Gentlemen:

El Paso Natural Gas Company is in receipt of shut-in Order SF-4162 ordering the Calloway Pool Unit #1, Section 27, T-31-N, R-11-W, Blanco Mesa Verde, shut-in until further notice for six times overproduction.

This well is the only well holding three fee leases all of which are beyond their primary term. El Paso is of the opinion that this well requires production each month to avoid possible loss of these three leases. In accordance with the provision of Order R-2404-A, El Paso hereby requests permission to produce this well up to 500 MCF per month until such time as it is released from shut-in.
