DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

Spudded 7-7/8" hole on September 30, 1959 and drilled to 219'. Ran 7-7/8" hole to 12-1/4" hole to 219'. 8-5/8" casing was set at 219' with 160 sacks of cement containing 2% calcium chloride. Circulated 77 sacks of cement. After waiting on cement, tested casing and water shut off with 400 psi for thirty minutes which held with no indication of pressure drop. Reduced hole to 7-7/8" at 219' and resumed drilling operations.
