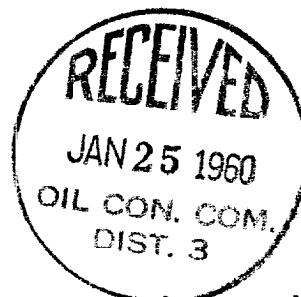

DETAILS OF WORK

Pulled liner and cleaned out open hole to total depth 3344'. Borehole slotted 4" liner from 3132-3344' with slots from 3230-3344'. Borehole tubing and landed at 3327. Ran rods and pump. Continue to recover lead oil. Well completed January 9, 1960 as pumping oil well Verde Gallup Field.
