Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Ute Mountain "B" Well No. 1 to be located 1060 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the East line and in the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 29, Township 31 North, Range 15 West, Verde Gallup Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.
