ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-2210, The Atlantic Refining Company has made application to the Commission on February 18, 1966, for permission to expand its Horseshoe-Gallup Unit Pressure Maintenance Project in the Horseshoe-Gallup Oil Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 10th day of March, 1966, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-2210.
- 4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-2210.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced pressure maintenance project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
 - That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, The Atlantic Refining Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Gallup formation through the following described wells for purposes of pressure maintenance, to wit:

Unit Well No. 5 located in the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 30, and Unit Well No. 7 located in the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 30, both in Township 31 North, Range 16 West, NMPM; the wells to be completed as outlined in the application dated February 15, 1966.
