





DETAILS OF WORK

Notice is hereby given of intention to drill the Ute Mountain Tribal 2-29#2X. 8 5/8" surface casing will be set at approximately 100 feet and 5 1/2" casing will be set at the top of the Tociro (approximately 3200'). The Tociro formation will be drilled through with cable tools and completion will be in open hole. This location is 50 feet east of the Ute Mountain Tribal 2-29#2 which was abandoned because the surface pipe parted.



I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
