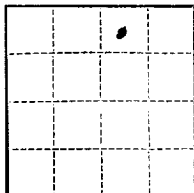

DETAILS OF WORK

A 7-7/8" hole was drilled to 3500' and 5 1/2" casing was cemented at 3500' with 150 sx ~~regular~~ 1:1 Pozmix with 4% gel and 100 sx regular around shoe and 100 sx regular thru multistage tool at 2381'. A cable tool rig was moved on the hole and a bailing test at 3501' recovered 12 BWPD and 1 1/2 BWPD. A cement retainer was set at 3433' and the shoe was cemented with 150 sx regular. After WOC a 4-3/4" hole was drilled to 3640'. After running logs the hole began caving and was being ~~cleaned~~ cleaned out at the end of the month.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
