DETAILS OF WORK

On October 13, 1956, the above well was perforated with four jet shots per foot from 2086 to 2114 feet and fracked with 41,000 gallons oil and 60,000 pounds sand. Formation broke at 1600 pounds. Injection rate was 51.8 barrels per minute. Unable to test. Still recovering load oil. Test information will be forwarded at a later date.
