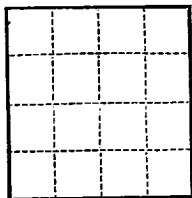

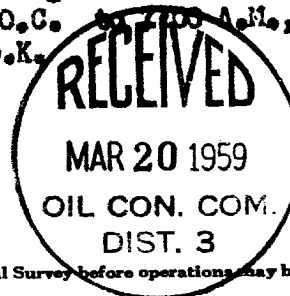

DETAILS OF WORK

Drilled to 1447' TD. Schlumberger ran SP Sonic log and Induction ES, their T.D. 1447'. Ran 4-1/2" O.D. 9.5#, J-55 casing = 1339.09'. Set at 1347.09' and cemented with 190 sacks regular mix Pozmix. Plug down 2:00 A.M., 3-12-59. Ran 2 Laricin centralizers at 1328' and 1269'. W.O.C. at 1:00 A.M., 3-13-59. Tested 4-1/2" casing with 1100# for 30 minutes, O.K.
