Dear Mr. Rogers:

We are returning two copies of Federal "Application for Permit to Drill" which we have received for your Navajo well located in Section 29-31N-18W. I believe that it is your intention that the "Farm or Lease Name" of this well should be Navajo and that the well number be #1. The Commission at the present time does not accept section numbers as part of the well number as this information is contained in the location.

Also, please indicate on the face of the Notice the deepest geological formation to be tested. You have not indicated on the Form C-102 the acreage dedicated to this well; however as it is a wildcat well we are temporarily showing an acreage dedication of 40 acres. In the event gas should be encountered, the wildcat gas spacing for New Mexico is 160 acres and an additional plat would be required prior to production of gas. The form should also be signed by the operator's representative in the blank indicated.

Dear Mr. Rogers:

We are returning two copies of General Application for Lease or Drilling which we have received for your New Mexico well located in Section 20-81N-18W, T. 20N. R. 18E. The information on the application is correct and we are in full agreement with it. The well number is 111. The location of this well should be shown on the well number map. The location of the well number at the present time does not agree with the number as part of the well number as this information is contained in the location.

Also, we are returning to you a copy of the notice of the location of the well formation to be located. You have not indicated on the Form O-102 the acreage dedicated to this well; however as it is a wildcat well we are temporarily showing an acreage dedication of 40 acres. In the event gas should be encountered, the wildcat gas spacing for New Mexico is 160 acres and an additional plat would be required prior to production of gas. The form should also be signed by the operator's representative in the blank indicated.
