On November 24, 1965 the above well was Logged by Schlumberger Well Service. The total depth of this well is 6975. On November 25, 1965 we ran D.S.T. #3 from 6736 to 6799, gas to the surface in 4 minutes. Tool open 5 minutes, Shut in 1 hour, tool open 1 3/4 hours, shut in 1 3/4 hours. Recovered 430' of free oil, 180' of mud cut oil, 300' of slightly salty water. I.H.P.-3865#, I.F.P.-337#, I.S.I.P.-3425#, F.F.P.-544#, F.S.I.P.-3412#, F.H.P.-3774#.

On November 26, 1965 we went in the hole with D.S.T. #4 from 6670 to 6735. We had a very weak blow and no gas to the surface when tool was opened. Tool open 5 minutes, shut in one hour, tool open one hour, shut in one hour. Recovered 270' of drilling mud. I.H.P.-3800#, I.F.P.-39#, I.S.I.P.-104#, F.F.P.-195#, F.S.I.P.-195#, F.H.P.-3735#.

On November 28, 1965 we ran 5 1/2" casing in this well with the D.V. tool at 2301'. Cemented first stage with 350 sacks of Class "C" cement with 4% gel followed this with 100 sacks of Class "C" neat cement. Circulated 3 hours through the D.V. tool, and then cemented second stage with 100 sacks Class "C" cement. Plug was down at 5:00 P.M. 11-28-65. W.D.C. 16 hours then drilled out the D.V. tool with a 4 3/4" bit and 2 7/8" tubing. We finished picking up 2 7/8" tubing, and cleaned out to 6940. We landed the tubing and started moving the rig off so we could move in a work over rig. 12-1-65.

Instructions
