July 9th	0 Bbls.

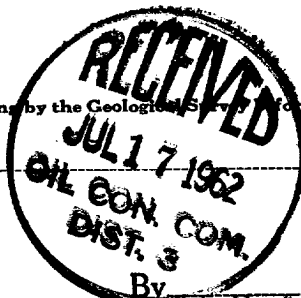
