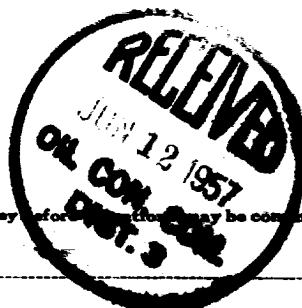

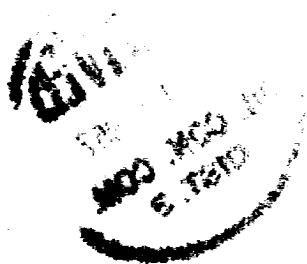
DETAILS OF WORK

Notice is hereby given of intention to drill the Ute Mountain Tribal #4-1 Tocito well to a TD of approximately 1950 feet. Surface 9 5/8" casing will be set at approximately 250 feet. An 8 3/4" hole will be drilled with rotary tools to the top of the Tocito at approximately 1750 feet. A 7" casing string will be run at that depth and the last 200 feet will be drilled with cable tools.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before work may be commenced.

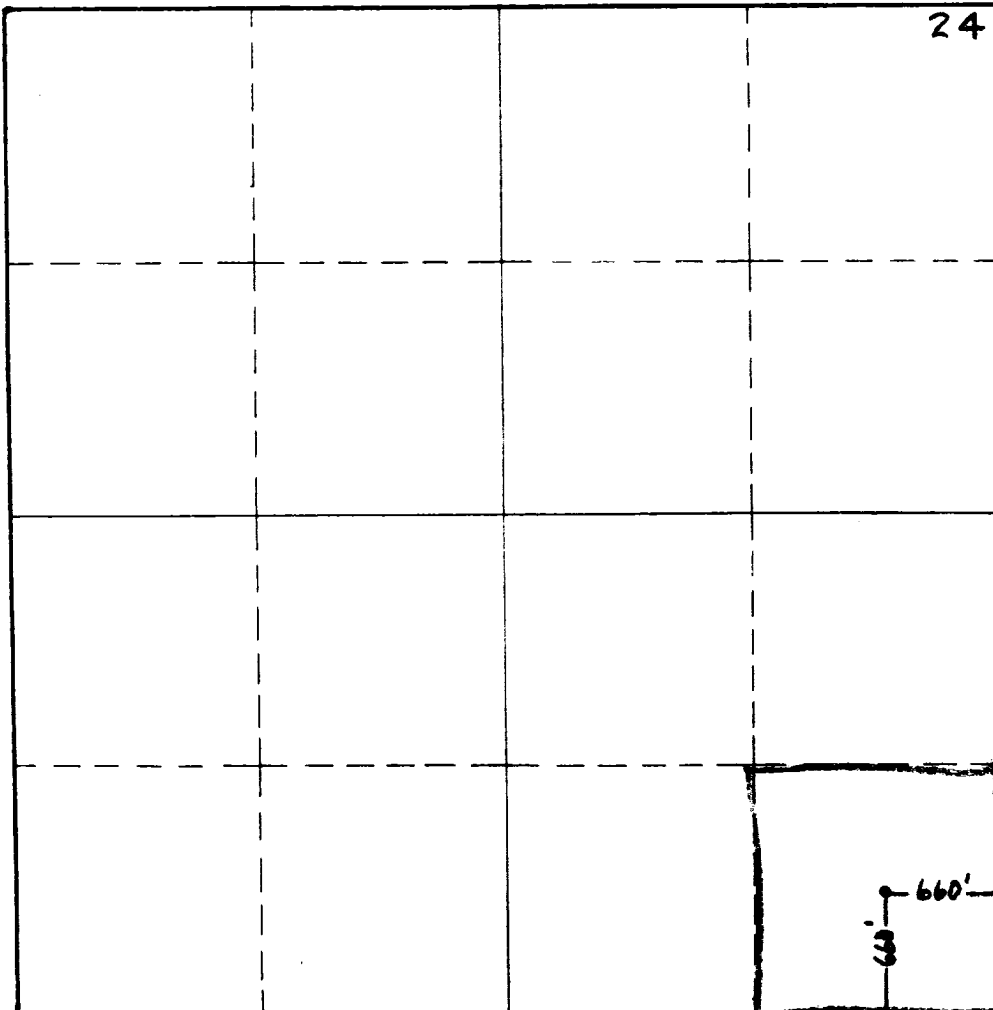
