DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casing, cement, and all other important proposed work)

The Ute Mountain Tribal #4-1 was spudded on 6-19-57. June 20, a 3 3/8" surface casing was set at 239 ft. undesignated with 125 sz reg nt cnt. An 8 3/4" hole was drilled to a depth of 1607' using fresh water as a drilling fluid. A string of 7" casing was set at 1606' and cemented with 250 sz reg nt cnt w/ 4% gel added. At the end of the month a 6000-lb rig was being moved onto location to drill through the Tequite formation to approximately 1850 ft.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
