Propose To: Set 100' of 5 5/8" surface casing and cement to surface.

Send-Oil free with 40,000 gals. oil and 40,000# sand (open hole)

Run tubing, rods and pump to complete.

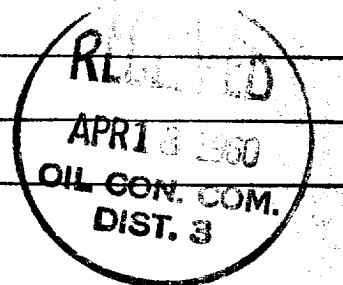
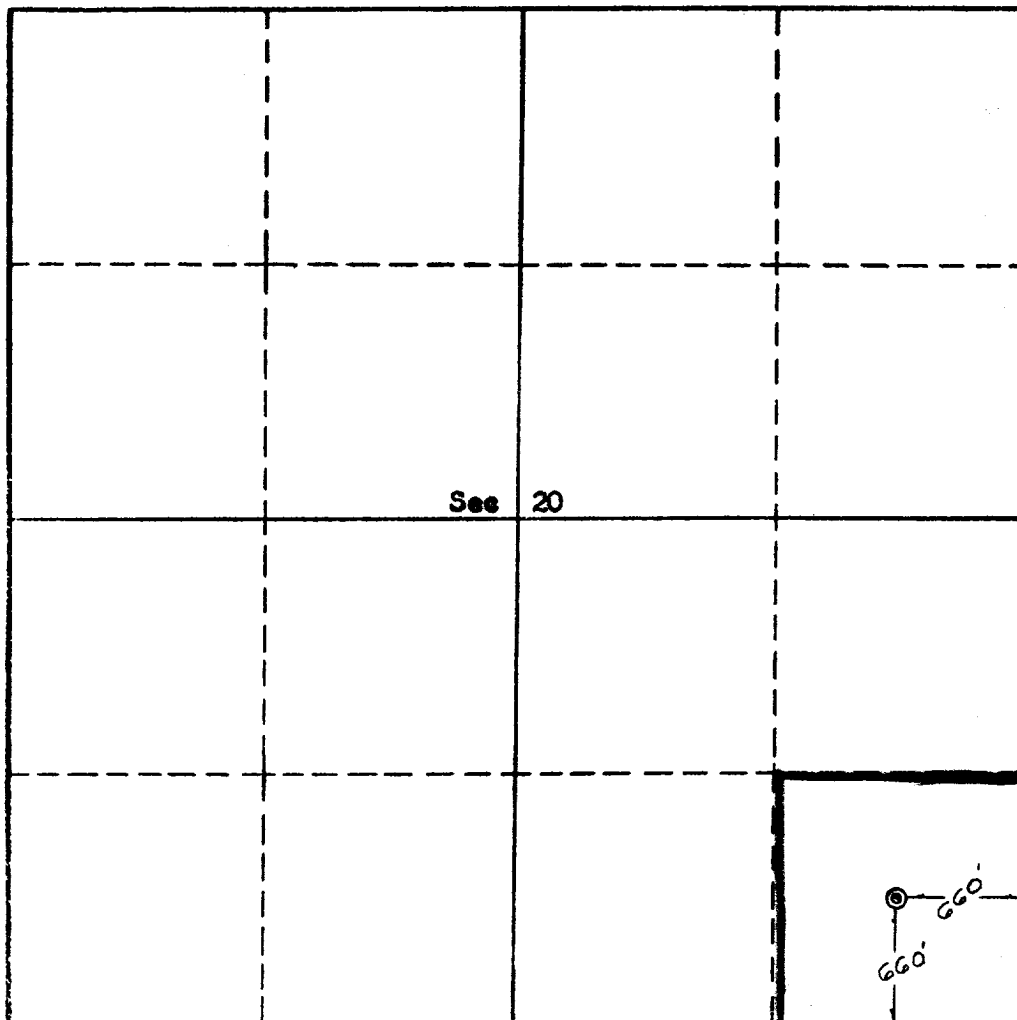
