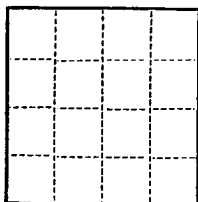

DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill a well with rotary tools through the Mesaverde, drilling the pay with gas circulation, and to shoot the entire Mesaverde with two quarts of S.M.G. per foot. Total depth 5513'.

Casing Program:

9-5/8" at 160' with 125 sacks of regular cement circulated to surface.
7" at 4315' with 300 sacks of regular cement.

The $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 23 is dedicated to this well.

Communitization will be filed as soon as possible.
