Dear Mr. Trueblood:

Reference is made to applications for dual completions that you have recently filed on your No. 1-24 Govt-Senter and No. 1-30 Govt-Lea wells, located respectively in SW/4 Sec 24-31N-13W and SW/4 30-31N-12W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is my understanding these wells are to be completed as gas-gas dual completions in the Mesaverde and Dakota formations. It is also my understanding that the zones will be isolated and that the Dakota formation will be produced through the casing-tubing annulus and the Mesaverde formation will be produced through the tubing. This will be accomplished by the use of a cross-over assembly such as was used on your No. 1-19 Southern Union Govt well in the SW/4 Sec 19-31N-12W.

Upon final completion of each of the above wells separate applications for final administrative approval shall be made to Mr. A. L. Porter Jr., Secretary of the Commission, Box 871, Santa Fe. At that time waivers from the offset operators shall be furnished along with schematic diagrams showing where packers are set and packer-setting affidavits. Packer leakage tests shall also be conducted in conjunction with your initial potential tests before the wells go on production, and annually thereafter with the annual deliverability tests. This office shall be notified seventy-two hours before the conducting of packer leakage tests.

Dear Mr. Thompson:

Reference is made to application for dual completion that you have recently filed on your 1-4-37-28-29 and 1-4-37-30-31-32 wells, located respectively in SW 1/4 Sec 28-31-13N and 1/4 Sec 30-31-13N, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is recommended that these wells are to be completed as gas-gas dual completions in the sandstone and shale formations. It is also recommended that the casing will be isolated and that the lateral completion will be provided through the casing on the side and the reservoirs remaining will be reached through the tubing. This will be accomplished by means of a cross-over assembly which was used on your 1-4-37-30-31-32 well in the 1-4-37-11A-12W.

Upon final completion of each of the above wells separate applications for final submission approval shall be made to Mr. H. A. Porter, Jr., Secretary of the Commission, Box 2711, Santa Fe, New Mexico, in accordance with the provisions of the Act. The operator shall be furnished with a schematic diagram showing the wellbore and the perforation and completion details. Perforation details shall also be furnished in conjunction with your initial perforation work before the wells go on production, and a summary of the work shall be submitted to the Commission. This office shall be notified seven days before the completion of the perforation work.
