*Reference is made to your letter of February 1, 1961 asking about the acreage factor assigned your #1 Southern Union -Government well in N-19-31N-12W in the Basin-Dakota Pool.*

*Your well was assigned an acreage factor of .5 in error and are issuing a supplement to correct it to .95 which is the proportional factor for 304.48 acres.*

*This is a non-standard unit under the Basin-Dakota order as it contains less than 320 acres. It has been agreed by the Commission that all operators will be given a 60-day period commencing February 1 to secure approval of non-standard units. This should be done by making application to Mr. A. L. Porter, Box 871, Santa Fe, as set out in the Basin-Dakota rules.*

Reference is made to your letter of February 1, 1961 asking about the acreage factor assigned your #1 Southern Union - Government well in the East-Dakota Pool.

This is a non-standard unit under the East-Dakota order as it contains less than 320 acres. 
Dear Mr. Arnold:
