DETAILS OF WORK

It is our intention to drill Well No. 2 to approximately 2375' to test the Gallup formation. Our casing program is as follows:

150' of 10-3/4" OD 32.75# casing, cemented with 150 sacks reg. cement, to be circulated.

2375' of 7" OD 23# casing, to be cemented with 250 sacks of cement, 100 sacks around casing shoe & 150 sacks through 2-stage tool at base of the Point Lookout at approximately 1295'.

The designated drilling unit is in the approximate center of the NE/4-SW/4 of Section 8-31N-14W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

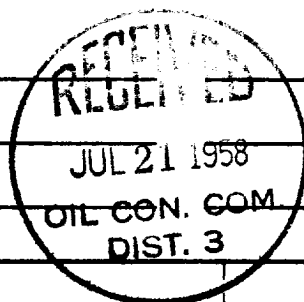

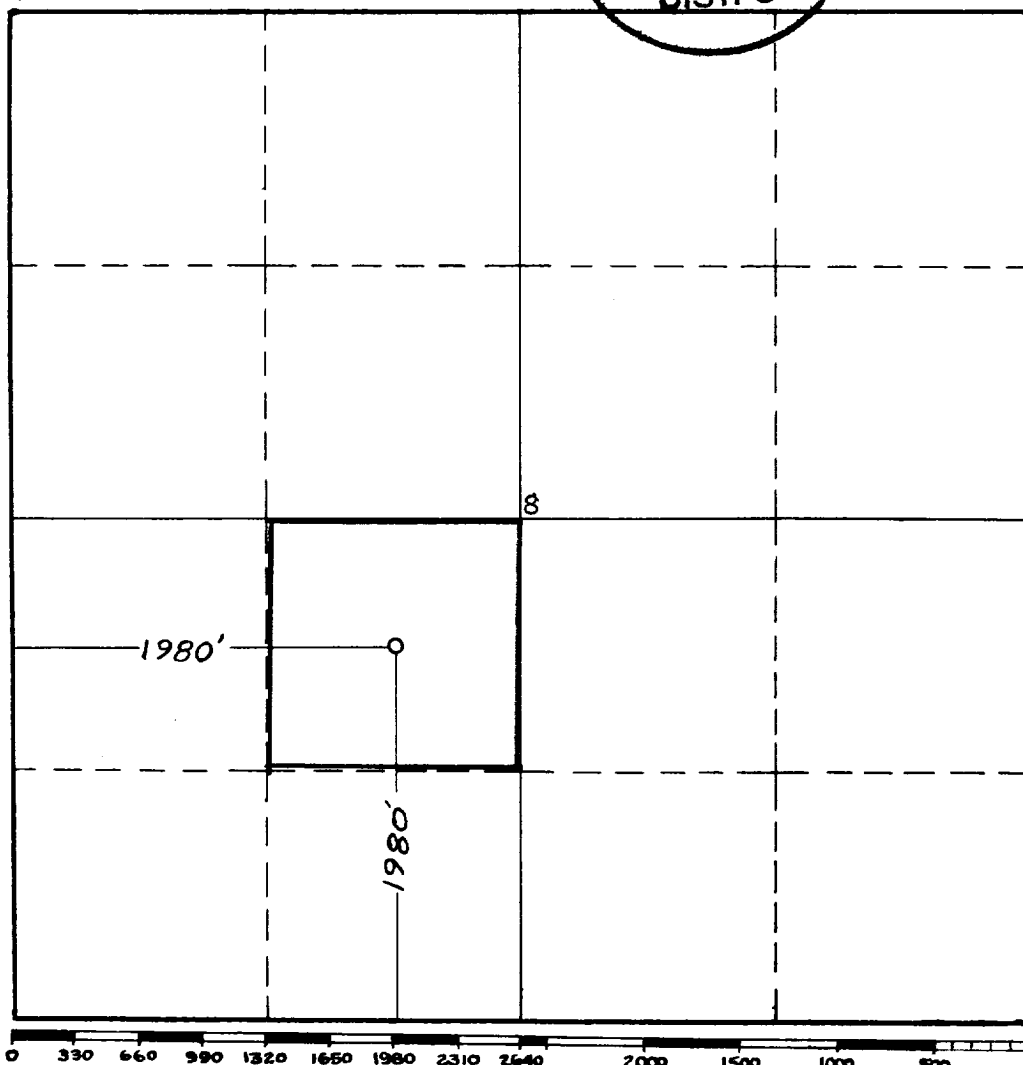
