
Dear Sir:

The 1961 deliverability test taken on the above subject well was 479 MCF gas per day, while the 1962 deliverability test was 512 MCF gas per day. The reason for the increase is that prior to the 1961 deliverability test the well was loading up with fluid. Since the 1961 test, the well has been blown systematically to clean out the fluid and as a result the deliverability test has increased.

We request the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to change the allowable basis for this well to the 1962 deliverability test since this represents the deliverability according to production.
