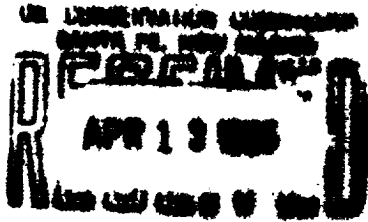

Gentlemen:

Astec Oil & Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprising the West half ( $W\frac{1}{2}$ ) (or lots 3,4,5,6,11,12,13 and 14, inclusive), of Section 11, Township 31 North, Range 12 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof respectfully states and shows the following:

1. That the Astec-Davis No. 1 well, located 1650 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the West line of Section 11, Township 31 North, Range 12 West, was completed December 7, 1949, as a gas well and connected to Southern Union Gas Company's pipeline on January 25, 1950.
2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 304.39 acres which are contiguous lots.
3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
5. Applicant is the only operator owning an interest in or offsetting the proposed unit.

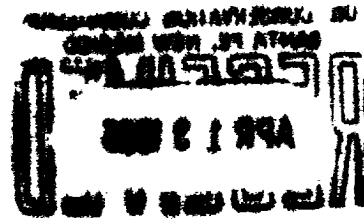
