DETAILS OF WORK

Spudded well at 1:00 p.m. 5-13-63. Drilled 11" hole to 100'. Ran 3 1/2" 8 5/8" O.D. 2 1/2" J-55 casing (91.71') set at 97.71'. Cemented with 60 sx common cement plus 2% CaCl₂. Plug down at 10:45 pm 5-13-63. Cement circulated.

W.O.C. 12 hrs. and released pressure. Tested 8 5/8 casing with 500 psi for 30 min. O.K. Blew hole dry and started drilling with air at 6:00 pm 5-14-63.
