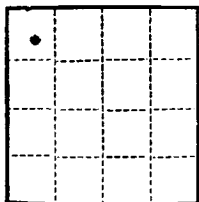

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

A 12 1/4" hole was drilled to 4980' at which point 9-5/8" casing was run and cemented with 200 sx of neat cement. After WOC 30 hours, the pipe was tested with 1500 psi for 30 minutes, and was found to be free of leaks. An 8-3/4" hole was then gas drilled to 5695. A 7" liner was set there and cemented with 125 sx of 50-50 Pozmix cement. After 30 hours WOC the pipe was tested with 1000 si for 30 minutes. A 6-1/8" hole was then drilled with gas to a TD of 6075' and the rotary rig was released. Presently the hole is waiting on a workover unit which will complete the well.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
