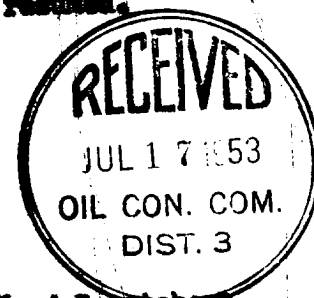

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The well was spudded at 12:30 P.M., June 4, 1953. On June 5, 1953, 9-5/8" casing was landed at 255 feet and cemented with 200 sacks of cement. Cement plug down at 9:02 P.M., June 5, 1953. At 9:00 A.M., June 7, 1953, casing and water shut-off were tested at 500 pounds for 30 minutes, with no drop in pressure. Thirty-eight feet of solid cement were drilled in bottom of pipe and water shut-off was again tested at 500 for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure during this test and drilling operations were resumed.
