ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A(II), Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc. made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on July 20, 1961, for permission to dually complete its O'Shea Well No. 1-3 located in the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 3, Township 31 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Mesaverde Formation adjacent to the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 9th day of August, 1961, the Secretary-Director finds:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section II of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;

(2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and

(3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.

(4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

(5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its O'Shea Well No. 1-3 located in the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 3, Township 31 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Mesaverde Formation adjacent to the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

- (2) That satisfactory information has been furnished
that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified, and
that no objections have been received within the
waiting period as prescribed by said rule;
- (3) That the proposed well completion will not cause
damage to any adjacent rights;
- (4) That the mechanics of the proposed well completion
are feasible and consistent with good conservation practice;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc.,
be and she is hereby authorized to drill and produce
oil and gas from the Blanco-Mesa Verde Pool and the Basin-
Mesa Verde Pool, in the NW 1/4 of Section 31, Township 31 North,
Range 13 West, NMMN, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such
a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco-
Mesa Verde Pool and the Basin-Mesa Verde Pool.
