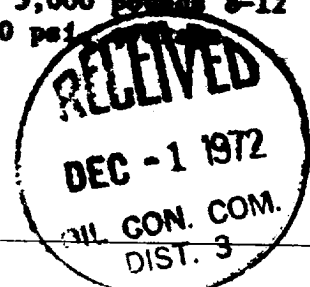
17. DESCRIBE PROPOSED OR COMPLETED OPERATIONS (Clearly state all pertinent details, and give pertinent dates, including estimated date of starting any proposed work. On November 19, 1972, perforated Dakota formation 3110-12 and 3117-19 with 2 SPF. Spotted 250 gallons 15% HCl and displaced. Swabbed 1-1/2 hours, recovering 43 BW, and shut in for night.

On November 20, 1972, shut in, swabbed and flowed well. Loaded hole with water with 1% KCl and pumped 25 BW into formation to kill well.

On November 21, 1972, set Model "D" packer at 3100'. Tested casing and blowout preventer with 3,000 psi OK. Spotted 500 gallons 15% HCl. Perforated 3000-04, 3022-26 and 3077-80 with 2 SPF.

On November 22, 1972, sand-water fraced with 21,588 gallons water with 1% KCl and 10 pounds Cal, 5,000 pounds 20-40 sand, 10,000 pounds 10-20 sand and 5,000 pounds 8-12 sand. Breakdown pressure 1000 psi, maximum treating pressure 2100 psi 1800 psi and AIR 43 BPM.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals for abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
