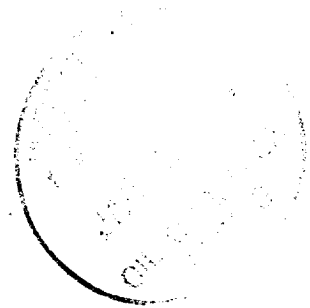


Development Plan For Surface Use

Verde Gallup Field

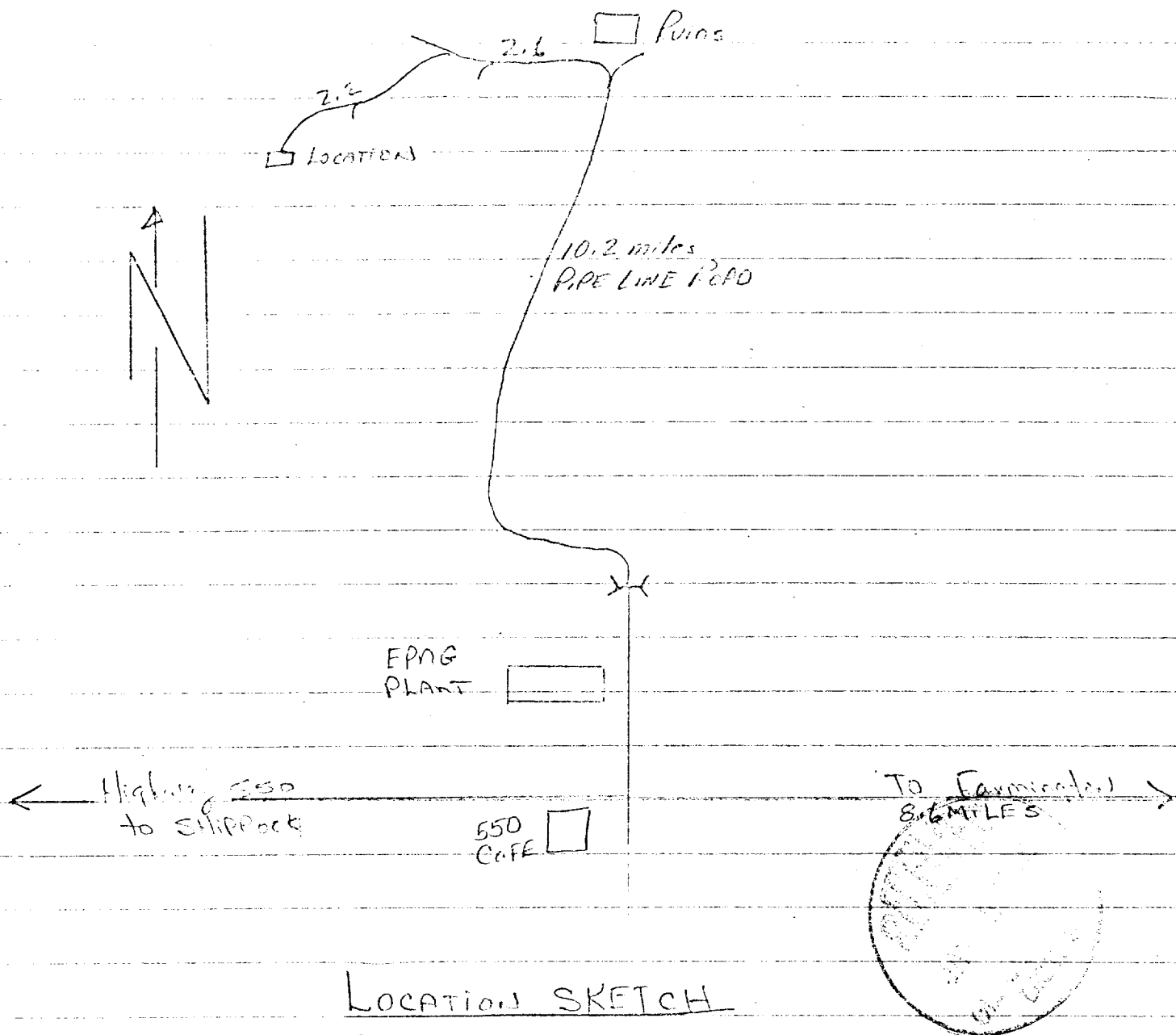
Minerals Management Inc. proposes to drill the subject well with rotary tools. A diagram of the location is attached. Established roads in the area will be utilized and road improvement will be required on small segments of these roads. Only 0.9 mile of new road will be required. Clearance of work will be obtained from the Ute Mountain Tribe, Towaoc, Colorado.

No camps or airstrips will be used or built for this location. The location falls on flat, sandy soil with sparse vegetation. Water for drilling will be hauled from the San Juan River. After completion the reserve pit will be filled and restored to natural terrain.

The well will be drilled with mud as the drilling fluid. Blowout preventer will be used during drilling.
