Gentlemen:

Attached in duplicate (to each office) are a well location plat C-102 with a sketch of the surrounding topography and an ownership plat for the above captioned Dakota well.

The proposed site of the Case A #3E has been relocated to 820 FNL, 600 FWL, Section 5, T31N, R11W, San Juan County, New Mexico. This places the well only 600' from the boundary line of the proration unit. This was the only feasible site due to topographical conditions and location of existing facilities as sketched on the C-102.

A copy of this application is being submitted to all offset operators by certified mail with a request that they furnish your Santa Fe office with a waiver of objection.

Pursuant to authority of Rule 104-F we respectfully request your approval of an exemption to the standard well location requirements.
