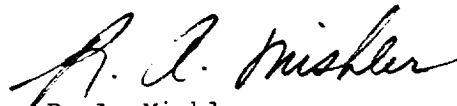
Attached in duplicate to each office are a well location plat C-102 with a sketch of the surrounding topography and an ownership plat for the above captioned Dakota infill well.
