Due to steep topography, this well was located where it does not conform to state spacing requirements. This is the only geologic and topographic site acceptable.

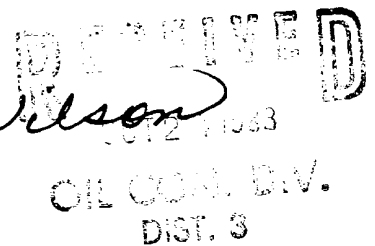
A copy of this application is being submitted to all offset operators by certified mail with a request that they furnish your Santa Fe office with a waiver of objection.

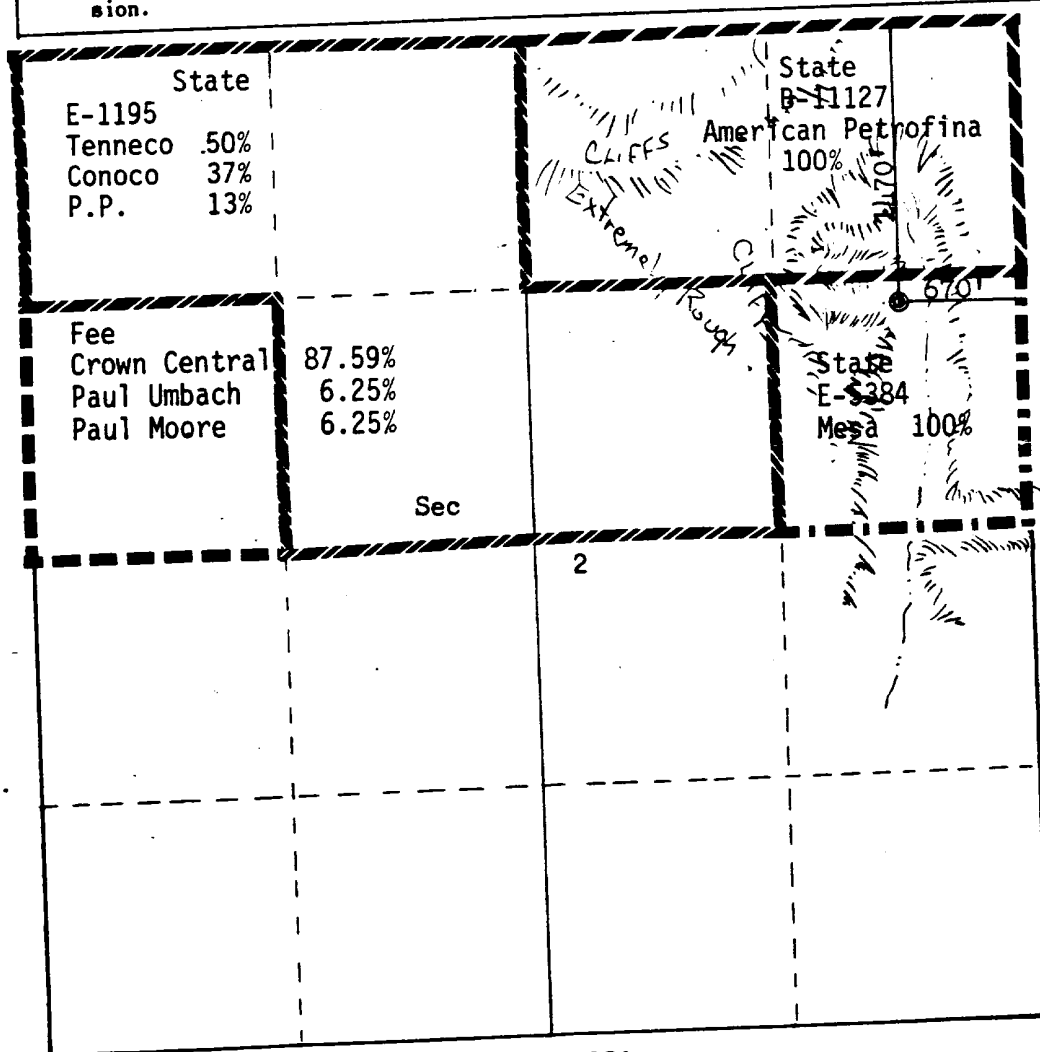

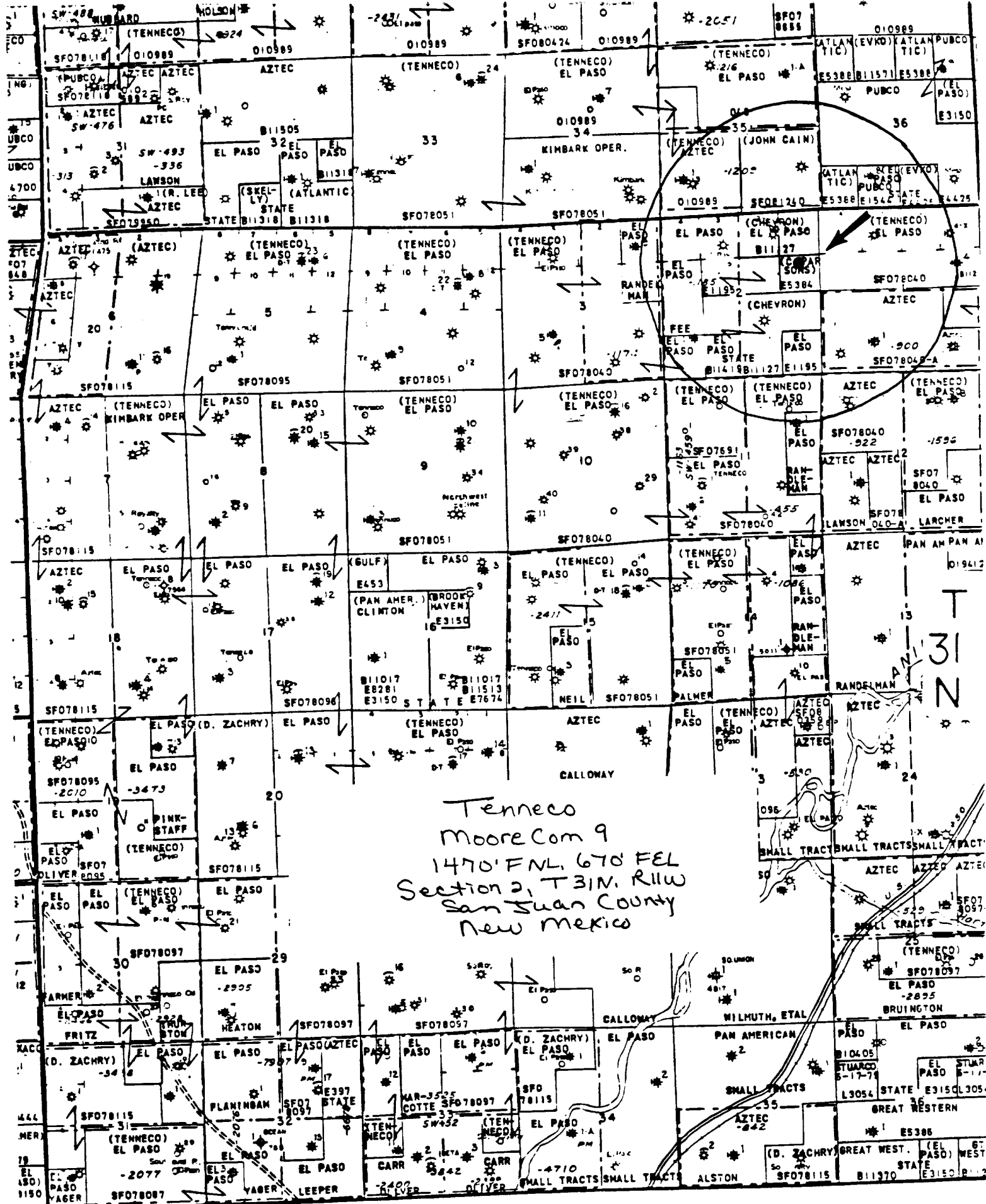
