Union Texas Petroleum requests permission to drill a monitor well at 1876' FSL & 2017' FWL, Section 21-T32N-R10W. A 8-3/4" hole will be drilled with air to 350'. Switch to mud and core to 500'. Run 8" Schedule 40 slotted PVC casing to 500'. The casing will not be cemented. Temporarily install downhole pump for drawdown test. Produced water to be disposed of in Payne 8 evaporation pit. There will be no new disturbance as this well will be located on the existing Payne 8 wellpad. Archaeologic clearance was recommended in Report No. 84-SJC-006. The Payne 8 was previously named Payne 2E. At such time as the well is no longer needed for monitoring purposes, a request for plugging instructions will be made.
