- 1. All flow lines shall be maintained in a same and adequate condition and any leaks or failures must by reported to the Division.
- All separation and liquids storage facilities shall be located on the originating lease.
- 3. The meter shall be read and maintained by the gas purchaser.
- 4. Federal or State approval required where applicable.

In addition, all production, storage, transportation, sales, and other operations shall comply with Division Rules and Regulations. It is the responsibility of the operator to notify the transporter of this approval.
