

Dear Ms. Bradfield:

Reference is made to your application dated February 5, 1999 for an exception to the well location requirements provided within the "Special Rules for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-10987-A, for a non-standard Blanco-Mesaverde infill gas well location in an existing standard 317.89-acre stand-up gas spacing and proration unit for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool comprising Lots 3, 4, 5, 6, 11, 12, 13, and 14 (W/2 equivalent) of Section 20, Township 32 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico. This unit is currently dedicated to Burlington Resources Oil & Gas Company's Newco Well No. 1 (API No. 30-045-26427), located at a standard gas well location 1660 feet from the South line and 1750 feet from the West line (Lot 11/Unit K) of Section 20.

The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rules 104.F and 605.B of the Rules and Regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division").

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Division Rule 104.F(2), the following described well to be drilled at an unorthodox infill gas well location in Section 20 is hereby approved:

Newco Well No. 1-A 2535' FNL & 400' FWL (Lot 5/Unit E).

Further, both of the aforementioned Newco Well Nos. 1 and 1-A and existing gas spacing and proration unit will be subject to all existing rules, regulations, policies, and procedures applicable to prorated gas pools in Northwest, New Mexico.

Burlington Resources is applying for administrative approval of an unorthodox gas well location for the Blanco Mesa Verde pool.

This application for the referenced location is due to the presence of archaeology, terrain as shown on the attached topographic map, and at the request of the Bureau of Land Management. The referenced location will require only 500' of new road construction.

Production from the Blanco Mesa Verde pool is to be included in a 317.89 acre gas spacing and proration unit for the west half (W/2) in Section 20. Production from the Blanco Mesa Verde is to be dedicated to the Newco #1 (30-045-26427) located at 1660'S 1750'W of Section 20.



Mesaverde Formation Well






2535' FNL & 400' FWL, SECTION 20, T32N, R9W, N.M.P.M. SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO






PLAT#1

Reserve Pit Dike: to be 8' above Deep side (overflow - 3' wide and 1' above shallow side). Blow Pit: overflow pipe halfway between top and bottom and to extend over plastic liner and into blow c
