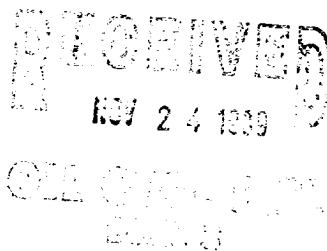

13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations

It is intended to workover the subject well in order to clean out bridges around and inside of the 5 1/2" liner. Pull the existing tubing and liner. Surge and clean out with gas until the openhole becomes stable. Rerun a 5 1/2" liner and land 2 3/8" tubing. Return the well to production.
