Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.



Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc. ("COG") requests an exception to "Rule 111. Deviation Tests and Directional Drilling" for the above captioned well.

COG purchased this property from Richmond Petroleum Company, effective January 1, 1994, and at that time assumed that Richmond Petroleum Inc. had filed all of the necessary and required forms for drilling operations of such well. It has recently been brought to our attention by your staff that the deviation tests had not been submitted by Richmond. We have extensively searched the files that were given to us by Richmond and have not come up with any deviation survey data.

The above well is currently on production and COG has filed the necessary reports since our takeover of this property. In our completion operations, we did not encounter any type of well bore problems that would indicate a deviated hole.

Please be informed that COG express mailed to Mr. Ernie Busch of your District 111 Aztec Office, by letter dated October 27, 1994, (see attached) copies of all pertinent data contained in our files pertaining to the wells we acquired from Richmond in New Mexico.

COG wishes to cooperate with the State of New Mexico in any way necessary and would like you to consider our request for exception on the above captioned well.
