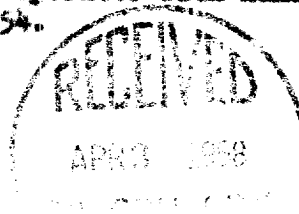
Well No. 54 is located 1050 ft. from 14N line and 1190 ft. from 14W line of sec. 14
