Reference is made to your application dated July 17, 1992 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your San Juan 32-7 Unit Well No. 235 to be located 463 feet from the South line and 1568 feet from the West line (Unit N) of Section 29, Township 32 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The W/2 of said Section 29 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre, more or less, gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.
